

## EU4EU Portugal

### The Project

The Project EU4EU Portugal - KA131-HED-91CA2F57, led by ISG | Instituto Superior de Gestão, was approved by the Erasmus+ National Agency, under Key Action 1, in September 2021.

This consortium aims to facilitate the transition between Higher Education and access to employment, through the organisation of professional internships abroad with a focus on EU projects, under the Erasmus + Programme.

The EU4EU Portugal Consortium will provide grants for highly qualified internship experiences of 2 to 6 months, using an inclusive approach for combined mobilities and digital and sustainable procedures.

### Objective

With the aim of maximising the impact on employment, internships promote the development of skills such as project management, communication in international environments, language and digital skills, analytical and problem-solving abilities that significantly enrich the trainees' curricular profiles and can be easily used in other professional sectors, which translates into an increase in the employment and self-employment prospects of the participants.

### **The Project and the EU4EU transnational network**

Regarding international partners, the collaboration with EuGen - European Generation, founder and international coordinator of EU4EU, allows the inclusion of the Portuguese Consortium in the EU4EU international network.

This connection supports the networking of HEIs with European Organisations and Foreign Higher Education Institutions, supporting new growth opportunities on the international scene, with exponential positive effects on local communities in terms of growth, innovation and employment.

The project foresees the detection of results, through data collection, analysis, reworking and publication of results at national and European level, which will have wide visibility through the EU4EU network and will be made available for the Erasmus + Programme.

### **Student Applications 2021-2023**

The EU4EU Portugal project promotes in the biennium 2021-2023 the allocation of 43 mobility grants for internships abroad to be carried out during the period from 1 February 2022 to 31 May 2023. The beneficiaries of the call are all students regularly enrolled (Bachelor and Master) in the universities of the consortium and who meet the requirements described in the call.
